


## Relationships are Important and Exciting

Relationships are a very important aspect of our lives. Most importantly ... we need a relationship with God!



# Jesus is knocking ... He wants to build a relationship with you

Why are you knocking, Lord?

In Saint Gregory's Liturgy, we say to the Lord:

"You are not in need of my servitude;

Rather, it is I who am in need of Your Lordship"

We are in need; yet He is knocking.

I ought to willingly let Him in.
He will not force His way into my heart.
I have to open to Him willingly to enter my heart,
to build & strengthen our relationship.

## Recipe for **Successful** Relationship

- Love
- Trust
- Honesty
- Communications
- Sacrifice
- Patience
- Forgiveness
- God's Presence

All of these are important in our:

- Relationships with one another
- Relationships with God



- Jesus loves you ... He has all the recipes for a successful relationship
  - Jesus loves you
  - You can trust Him
  - He is honest and the source of truth
  - He communicates His Word to you;
     He loves to hear from you
  - He sacrificed Himself for you
  - He is patient & longsuffering
  - He is the source of **forgiveness**

JESUS is genuinely LOVING & CARING.

JESUS is POWERFUL & ABLE to SAVE.

# Christianity is about Relationships

- Christianity is about Relationships
  - Not so much about rules.
- Christianity is about a Person (Our Lord Jesus)
  - More than a philosophy.
- Christianity is about our Relationships
  - Relationships with God (1st) & each other
  - The greatest commandment is to love God
  - The second greatest is to love our neighbour



## How does **God** fit in?

We were created to live in a <u>relationship with God</u>.

Until we find that relationship, there will always be something MISSING in our lives.

We are often aware of a GAP, a VOID, an EMPTINESS

- People try to fill this emptiness in different ways
  - Money, Drugs, Alcohol, Improper relationships
  - Over-working, Music, Sports, Success (not "bad" per se)
- None of these satisfy the hunger deep inside of us.
- Even the closest human relationships, wonderful as they are, do not satisfy this emptiness deep inside
- Nothing will fill the gap except <u>relationship with God</u>

# Why (when) do we feel empty?

As a human race, we feel empty because we turned our back on God.

Jesus sais, "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35)

Jesus is the only One who can satisfy our deepest hunger.


He is the One who makes it possible for our relationship with God to be restored.

Individually, we feel empty when we still turn our back on God.

# How does Jesus fill our emptiness?


### Jesus is the Bread of Life:

- Jesus satisfies our hunger for Meaning & Purpose in Life
- Jesus satisfies our hunger for Forgiveness
- Jesus satisfies our hunger for Life beyond Death





## Jesus gives Meaning & Purpose in Life



"What am I doing on earth?"
"What is the point of life?"
"Is there any purpose to life?"

- We cannot answer such deep questions until we live in a relationship with God
- We can only find the true (and ever-lasting)
  meaning and purpose of life, through a
  relationship with God
- We may find passing (temporary) satisfaction elsewhere, but it will not last

# Jesus gives Forgiveness

- We have all done things we know are wrong
- We all have a great need to be forgiven
- Whether we recognize it or not, we all need forgiveness
- Jesus made it possible for us to be forgiven, bringing us back into a relationship with God

## Jesus gives Life beyond Death

- Without Christ, death is scary, an unknown
- We long to survive beyond death
- Through Christ, death from this world is only a departure to eternal life
- Our relationship with God starts here & now, and continues beyond death, unto eternity!

# Jesus also gives Freedom

- Freedom from what?
  - Fear
  - Guilt
  - Addiction (Slavery)
- Freedom for what?
  - To know Him, love Him
  - To build a relationship with Him
  - To change for the better through God's Holy Spirit



# God's gifts to us ...

#### Through Jesus Christ, God offer us these gifts:

- His Holy Spirit to live within us & transform us
- Meaning & Purpose
- Forgiveness
- Eternal Life
- Freedom


## **Our choice:**

## Sometimes we reject God's gifts

#### **Common Excuses**

- I have no need of God ...Really?!
- There is too much to give up ...
   There is actually more to gain!
- There must be a trap ...
   There is no trap, His gifts are free!
- I'm not good enough ...
   Nobody is good enough, but His love is great enough!
- I could never keep it up ...
   Come to Him, and He will help!
- I'll come to Him later ...
   Delaying is very dangerous!

# We are called to accept God's gifts

Accept to build a relationship with God.

#### **Start with the Basics**

- 1 Saying "Sorry"
- 2 Saying "Thank You"
- 3 Saying "Please"

   O God, Our Saviour!
- Have Mercy (3x)
   Have Mercy Upon Us
   And Have Mercy!

## We are called to accept God's gift

## 1 Sorry, Lord

I go running **back to Him** asking for **forgiveness**.

## 2 Thank You, Lord

I believe that Jesus died on the cross for me, and **thank Him** for His free gifts of Forgiveness, Freedom, and the Holy Spirit.

## 3 Please, Lord

God will never force His way into my life. I need to willingly accept His gifts, and invite Him to come and live within me by His Holy Spirit.

1 Sorry

Lord, forgive me and have mercy on me (Psalm 50)

2 Thank You

We thank You in everything, for everything, concerning everything!

3 Please

Stay with me, bless me, save me, fill me, Enlighten me, lead me, guide me, carry me!

## The Lord asks, "Do you love Me?"

- Yes, Lord, you know I love you
- Do you really love me?
  - You ignore Me
  - You block Me out
  - You don't read about Me
  - You don't seek to understand Me
  - You don't talk to Me; yet you talk to others
  - You don't run to see Me; yet you run to others
  - You don't listen to Me; yet you listen to the world
  - You don't talk about Me; yet you talk about others
- Sorry, Lord
  - Please teach me how to love You more …

### **Good News!**

- Question: How close are you to God today?
- Good news:
   The answer to the above question is not as important as the answer to the next question ...
- Next Question:
   Are you willing to make an effort to come closer to God?
- Come closer to Him and say
   Sorry, Thank You, Please ...

3 Please




### **More Good News**

- Successful Relationships need Love, Trust, Honesty, Communications, Sacrifice, Patience, Forgiveness
- Most Importantly, they need God's Presence
- Christianity is about Relationships: with God (1st) and with one another
- The greatest commandment is to LOVE GOD; the second greatest is to LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOUR
- We were created to live in a RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD
- Until we find that relationship with God, there will always be something MISSING in our lives
- We are often aware of an EMPTINESS, and try to fill it in different ways (some good, some not)
- No money, drugs, alcohol, or improper relationship can fill that EMPTINESS
- Neither can over-working, music, sports or success fill that EMPTINESS
- Neither can the closest human relationships, wonderful as they are, fill that EMPTINESS
- Only a RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD can fill that EMPTINESS
- As a human race, we feel empty BECAUSE we turned our back on God.
- Individually, I feel empty WHEN I still turn my back on God.
- Jesus is the only ONE who can satisfy our deepest hunger: "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE" (John 6:35)
- Jesus makes it possible for our **RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD** to be restored.
- Jesus satisfies our hunger by giving us **MEANING & PURPOSE IN LIFE**
- Jesus satisfies our hunger for **FORGIVENESS**
- Jesus satisfies our hunger for LIFE BEYOND DEATH
- Jesus also gives us **FREEDOM from Fear, Guilt, Addiction (Slavery)**
- Jesus gives us FREEDOM to Know Him, Love Him, Build a relationship with Him
- Through Jesus, we also have the Gift of the **Holy Spirit** to dwell within us, and change us for the better
- I have a choice: do I choose to REJECT or ACCEPT God's gifts?
- Sometimes we reject for a variety of excuses, but God still loves us, knocks, waits for us to open to Him
- We are called to accept His wonderful gifts, and Build a relationship with Him ...
- We can start with the Basics, by saying "Sorry", "Thank You", and "Please, Lord"
- It doesn't matter so much if I am far from God, or near to Him today ...
- What matters is, "Am I willing to make an effort to come closer to God?"
- Come closer, so He can hug you tight! He loves you, died for you, so you can live. Come closer to Him!
