



ACTIVATE

- Activate the Holy Spirit in your life (allow God's Spirit to work with & within you)
- Do NOT grieve the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 4:30)
 - ³⁰ And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- Do NOT quench the Spirit (1 Thessalonians 5:19)


 19 Do not quench the Spirit.

- But do resist evil spirits (James 4:7)
 - ⁷ Therefore submit to God.

 Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Luke 10:17-20


The Seventy Return with Joy


Philippians 4:4-7



²⁶ Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed.



PEACE

(be a messenger of God's peace)

John 14:27

²⁷ Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Luke 10:1-6

After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

⁵ But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.'

⁶ And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.





PERSEVERE

2 Corinthians 4

(The Lord will never allow you to be tempted beyond your ability)

- ⁸ We are hard-pressed on every side, yet <u>not</u> crushed; we are perplexed, but <u>not</u> in despair;
- ⁹ persecuted, but **not forsaken**; struck down, but **not destroyed**—
- ¹⁰ always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. ¹¹ For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.

(How to persevere? By keeping our eye on the prize, eternal glory!)

¹⁶ Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸ while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.


SERVE

James 4:7


⁷ Therefore <u>submit</u> to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

¹² Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own <u>salvation</u> with fear and trembling




SACRAMENTS



- ³⁹ And the second is like it: 'You shall **love your neighbor as** yourself.'



Romans 8




- ² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
- ³ For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,
- ⁴ that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
- ⁵ For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.
- ⁶ For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
- ⁷ Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.
- ⁸ So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.
- ⁹ But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.
- ¹⁰ And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
- ¹¹ But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through **His Spirit who dwells in you**.



LIVE a true Christian Life LIGHT to the world

Galatians 2

²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ; **it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me**; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.



John 8

¹² Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

Matthew 5

¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

EFFORT

Make a <u>serious</u> **effort** to:

- Repent ...
- Weep bitterly in regret as Peter did after he sinned
- Ask the Lord what He wants you to do, as Paul did on the road to Damascus

Repentance of Peter (Luke 21)

⁶¹ And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times."

⁶² So Peter went out and wept bitterly.

Repentance of Paul (Acts 9)

⁵ And he said, "Who are You, Lord?"

Then the Lord said,

"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.

It is hard for you to kick against the goads."

⁶ So he, trembling and astonished, said,

"Lord, what do You want me to do?"



EFFORT

Make a <u>serious</u> **effort** to:

- Repent
- Serve
- Give
- Forgive
- Love

If you are called to **evangelize** ...

- Spread the Word of God through Christian Action (lead by example, not just by words)
- Make sure your actions are louder than words

Make a <u>serious</u> **effort to be**:

- Engaged
 during the Liturgy,
 in Midnight Praise,
 helping others, serving
- Energetic in prayers, in repentance, in service
